Do Not Grow Weary Of Doing Good!
Since returning from the Sixth World Congress of Families in Spain I have been working on several projects simultaneously. God has opened many significant doors to advance His kingdom.

The Congress culminated with the "Madrid Declaration" – a statement of pro-family principles.

Some of the divine connections at the Congress was meeting Sharon Slater of Family Watch International. Sharon heads a ministry that acts as a Christian watchdog at the United Nations.

Many anti-Christian and anti-family policies are formulated at the UN and imposed on member nations. Western nations are using aid-funding as a weapon to force African nations to adopt pro-abortion and pro-homosexual policies - despite overwhelming opposition from its citizens.

FWI produced a disturbing documentary entitled "Cultural Imperialism" which exposes the West's bullying tactics. Please use the password 'fwi' to view the trailer of this excellent documentary.

I have discussed the possibility of establishing a SA chapter of the Alliance Defense Fund with Benjamin Bull – the Executive Director of ADF Global. ADF is the largest Christian lawyers movement in the world defending Christian freedoms and opposing anti-Christian discrimination.

I have invited Benjamin to visit South Africa soon to address our Christian legal practitioners with a view to establishing a similar movement to defend Christian values and freedoms in South Africa.

I am waiting on confirmation to meet with the DG of Communications, Ms Rosey Sekese and the CEO of ICASA who are currently in Cape Town to discuss the urgent need to amend legislation to specifically prohibit pornography on TV and to install filters on the internet to block online porn.

Homosexual activist, Jacques Rosseau has slammed the Film & Publication Board for its association with Family Policy Institute. Apparently, my work to protect children from exposure to porn on TV and the internet is considered "censorship" a crime worse than the social degradation of children.

I have also written to the Social Development Minister, Bathabile Dlamini to convene a symposium between her department and key Christian leaders to discuss the Green Paper on Families.

The objective is to provide a forum for denominational & independent Church leaders and government to find ways to achieve the pro-family goals set out in the Green Paper.

Please pray for all of the above objectives. I need God's wisdom & direction to make this happen.

The good news is that the long overdue 'Prevention & Combating of Trafficking in Persons Bill' was finally adopted by the Justice Committee and will be passed and signed into law soon.

Trafficking of young girls for prostitution is rife in SA. This legislation is an urgent priority.
